

Social Story

Visiting John Tonkin College Education Support Centre



Guidelines

A social story uses storytelling techniques to explain new experiences and environments. Anyone who is nervous when attending a place or event for the first time may benefit from access to a social story.

We recommend you follow these guidelines:

- Read the social story preferably two weeks in advance of visit.
- If reading to someone, help the person to understand key points.
- Once the visit has taken place, re-read the social story to celebrate achievements.



This social story is for people visiting John Tonkin College Education Support Centre (JTCESC).



Location

JTCESC is located within John Tonkin College - MET Campus.

It is next to South Metropolitan TAFE and Murdoch Univerity's Mandurah Campus.

It is 300m away from Bunnings Mandurah.



Transport

If I travel to JTCESC by car, there is visitor parking for me to use at the front of the campus.

If I have an ACROD permit, I can use the ACROD parking bays.

If I choose to travel by bus, I may get off the bus at the stop on Education Drive.

I might choose to use a map on a phone or device to know where to get off the bus or where to park.



To start my visit at JTCESC, I will need to sign in at the administration office.


To find the administration office, I will follow the signs that say "John Tonkin College Education Support Centre Administration."



When I arrive, I will see people at reception who work at JTCESC. They are called staff.

The staff will say hello to me, and I can tell them the reason I am visiting JTCESC. I may be asked to sign in on the iPad.

If I have any questions, I can ask the staff.



I will follow the directions of the staff, and let them know if I need any assistance.

If I need assistance and there isn't a staff member or trusted adult around, I will call the reception phone on 9583 0571.




There are lots of things to see at JTCESC.
