The Secondary Assistance Scheme (SAS) is to assist low-income families with secondary schooling costs for students in Years 7 to 12.

It is made up of 2 allowances:

- the Education Program Allowance (EPA) paid directly to the school \$235.00
- the Clothing Allowance (CLA) paid to the applicant or the school \$300.00

Eligibility

Concession cards

To be eligible for the scheme, the parent or guardian must hold at least one of these concession cards:

- Centrelink Health Care Card
- Centrelink Pensioner Concession Card
- Veterans' Affairs Pensioner Concession Card (blue) card.

The concession card must:

- be valid for at least 4 weeks.
- be valid for some time within Term 1, 2025 (5 February to 11 April 2025)
- have the student listed on it
- not be expired at the time of applying for SAS.

Note:

If a Year 11 or 12 student (or student with a disability or health condition) is not listed on the parent or guardian concession card, both the parent or guardian and student must produce their cards.
